

Colin E. Hackett Endowed Engineering Research Award (Graduate) – up to \$5,000

Description:

The Colin E. Hackett Endowed Engineering Research Award was established by an endowment to the University of California, Riverside, from the Hackett Family to encourage and aid graduate students in pursuit of careers in engineering and doing research at CE-CERT. The fellowship is given annually to a full-time graduate student to offset University of California, Riverside, academic and/or research expenses.

Eligibility:

- 1. Have a working relationship with CE-CERT;
- 2. Be a full-time graduate student at the University of California, Riverside;
- 3. Be currently pursuing, or planning to pursue, a graduate degree in engineering at the Bourns College of Engineering;
- 4. Preferences to women and/or under-represented minorities.
